The Grammar module is offered at different levels. By means of language assessment test at the beginning of the winter course we will help you to find the most suitable group.

Language Training

In the Language Training module, which is also offered at different levels, you will actively practise your oral and writing skills. Speaking, reading and writing in German will be trained by working on a variety of up-to-date topics taken from society, economy, culture and technology in Germany. Project work in small groups (2-4 persons) supplements the language training at the higher language levels.
